BATHURST

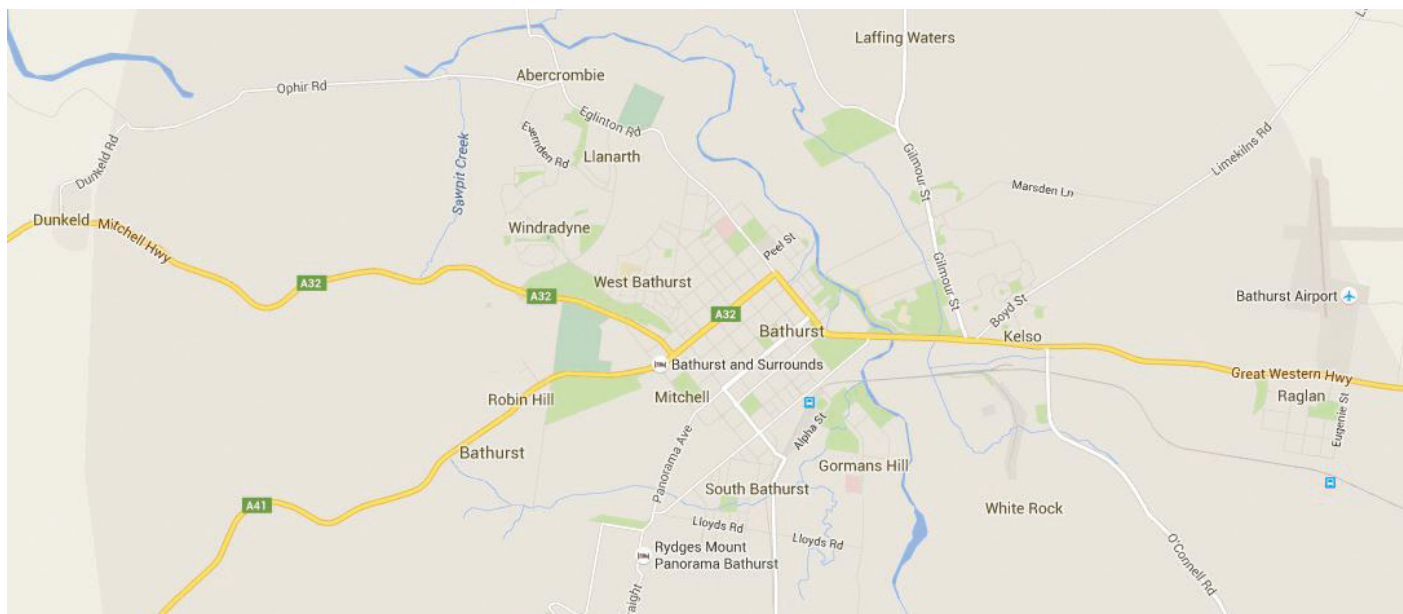
Bring the family, take a break from the road, and enjoy all that Bathurst has to offer.
